## **Wound Treatment:**



12/19
Post-surgical debridement,
prior to VetBlue PVA being used.
Clear evidence of necrotic tissue.



12/19
VetBlue PVA placed in wound and wound was sutured, with small window for monitoring the color of the dressing.





12/24
Sutures were removed and dressings were extracted.
Dressing had changed color from blue to white,
indicating uptake of heavy bioburden.





12/24
The Result: a clean wound cavity with granulating tissue.
